About The Institute

The State Institute of Public Administration and Rural Development (SIPARD) is a composite institute functioning both as the State Administrative Training Institute (ATI) and the State Institute of Rural Development (SIRD) for the State of Tripura.

The Institute is functioning under the registered Society called, ‘Society for Training and Research on Public Administration and Rural Development’. It is a registered Autonomous Body and registered as a society under the Registration of Societies Act, 1860. The Institute is functioning popularly in the name of the “State Institute of Public Administration and Rural Development” (SIPARD). It functions under the supervision of the General Administration (Personnel & Training) Department of the State Government.

Research on various issues like administrative, social, developmental, technological, environmental etc, as well as, consultancy services are some of the different activities of SIPARD. The Institute was set up in 1987 with the name "Administrative Training Institute" and functioned as an Apex Training Institute of the State with the mandate to train the staff and officials at various levels of the State Government. In 1999, the Institute was renamed as "State Institute of Public Administration and Rural Development (SIPARD)" when it also started functioning as the ‘State Institute of Rural Development (SIRD)’.

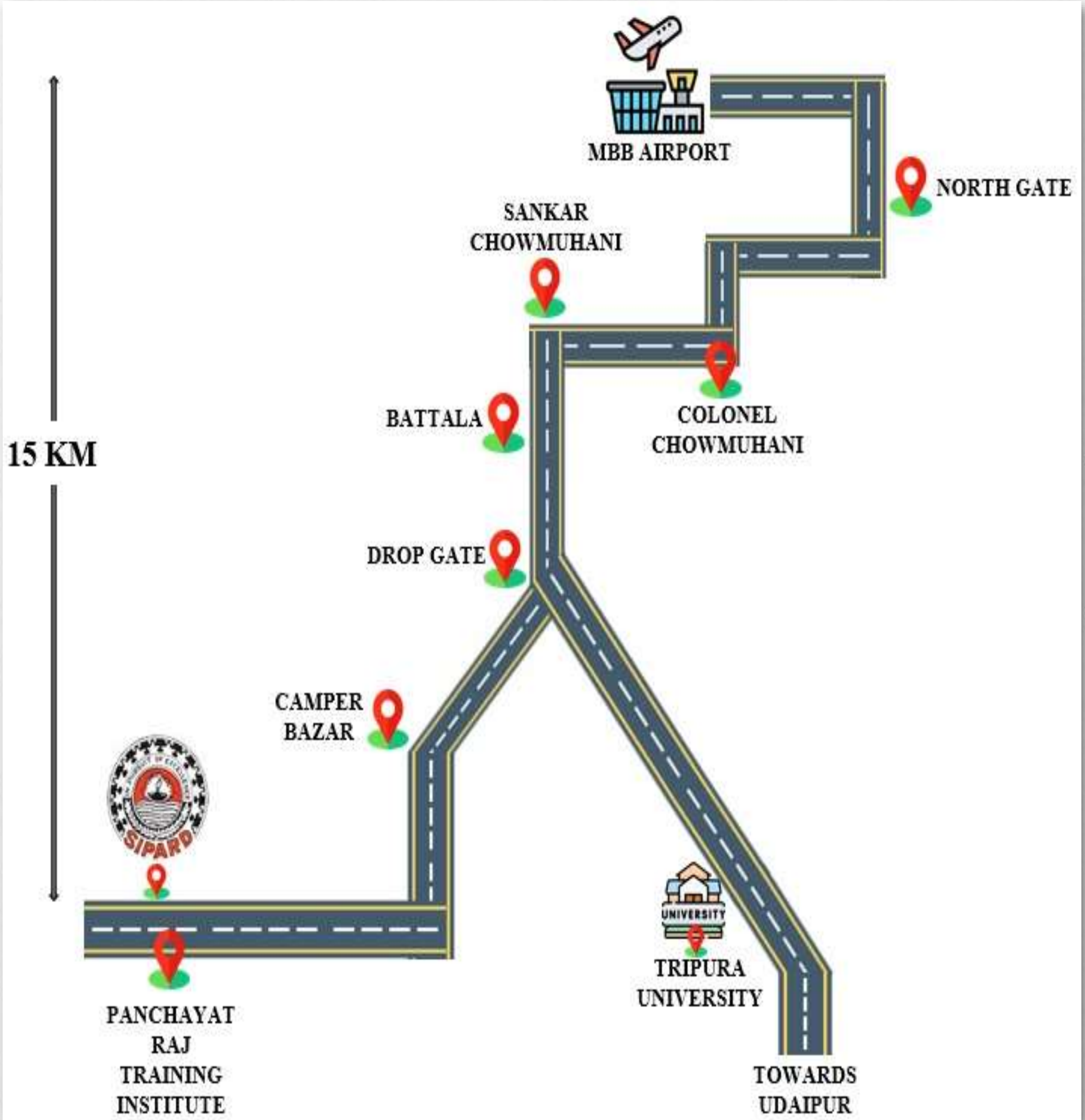
Location

The SIPARD is situated in a campus of 7.2 acres of land at Arundhuti Nagar (A.D. Nagar), Agartala. The locality in which it is located is called Camper Bazaar. The Post Office is Sarva Dharma Mission (S.D Mission) and is under the jurisdiction of the A.D Nagar Police Station.

SIPARD is in an institutional area. On it's opposite is the Panchayati Raj Training Institute (PRTI) of the Rural Development and Panchayat Department, Regional Survey and Training Institute (RSTI) of the Land Records and Settlement Department. To the Institutes right are the Cooperative Training Institute, under the Cooperative Department, Swavalamban and Rural Development Self Employment Training Institute (RuDSETI), under the Rural Development Department.

SIPARD is only 5.3 Kms from the City Centre of Agartala, the state's capital. It is well connected by Air and Rail. SIPARD is 14.1 Kms from the Maharaja Bir Bikram Airport and 5.8 Kms from Agartala Railway Station. The three major bus terminals connecting the city to other districts and the Inter State Bus Terminal (ISBT) are located not very far from the Institute i.e. within a distance of 4 to 9.6 Kms.

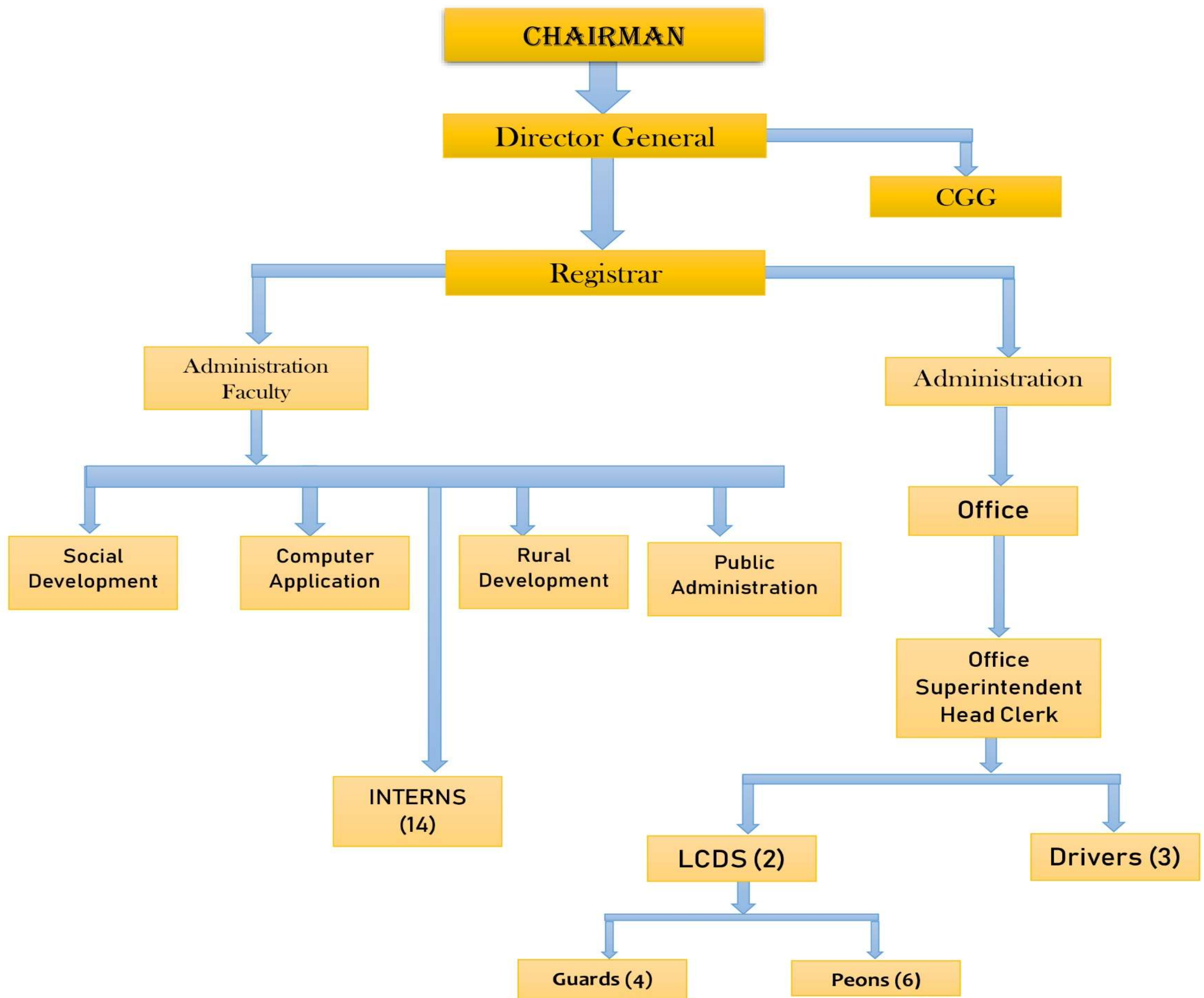

Training Plan of SIPARD

Introduction:

The State Institute of Public Administration and Rural Development (SIPARD) is the Apex Training Institute of Government of Tripura for providing training to all government officials and other development functionaries of the State. The overall objective of the Institute is to attain “Training for All” employees of the State starting from the lowest and cutting-edge to the highest in policy making level.

The Institute mostly organizes DoPT, MoRD and other Ministries of Govt. of India and State Government department sponsored training courses. The training achievement of last five years shows that SIPARD conducts around 200 Training Programmes per annum for 6000 Government Officials and other Functionaries. In the last two/three years the Institute has increased the coverage to around 10,000 participants per year.

As per mandate the Institute needs to organize training for at least 50-60 thousands participants per year to complete one cycle of training for the targeted population by 3 years. But, the present mode may take 17-18 years to train the entire target group. Therefore an effective training plan is required to increase the coverage.

The Need:

Till a few years back, average coverage of the institute was only 3 % of the Government Officials and other Functionaries. In the last two years it has been increased to about 6-8%. So, there is a need for six fold expansion of coverage to achieve the target of “Training for All” employees and functionaries.

Objectives:

The objectives of the training plan are –

- . To train every employee at least once in three years.
- . To increase the reach of SIPARD through decentralization of training to many locations.
- . To develop adequate number of trainers.
- . To develop training infrastructures.

Training Coverage:

The total training coverage of the Institute shall be divided in three major sections –

- a) Government Employees of all categories
- b) Elected Representatives of Urban and Local Bodies
- c) Non-government key functionaries

Training Target:

Training of senior officers – strategy to be developed with Government guidance. Could include special sessions, out of state training etc

- . For others, primarily within State but with special interventions
- . For departments having own training Institutes, administrative type of training with standard governance module will be provided
- . For all others, with the help of the department concerned, both technical and non technical training can be coordinated.

Content: The course content shall be divided in two broad areas -

a. Standard training module or Governance module:

- . Training focus on Functional and Motivational fronts
- . Aim of training is to Improve Skill Set (functional) and make employee a responsible citizen and responsible Government Servant (Motivational)
- . Standard Governance module developed for motivational and general skill set aspects
- . Covers Shistachar, Etiquette, Office Management, Office Maintenance, Public Health & Hygiene, Waste Management and Day-to-day Economics.
- . Session on Departmental Objectives and role of target groups in achieving the same— where feasible

b. Tailor made courses for departments

- . In consultation with department
- . Could cover other non Government key stakeholders
- . Content etc to be finalised with departmental inputs.
- . Funding also expected from departments

Mode of Training:

Training shall be imparted at SIAPRD or at the work places or decentralized basis at District, Sub-Divisional, Block/ Nagar Panchayat levels or by online mode.

Roll out Strategy

- . Training profile of employees being built
- . Priority to cover those not trained earlier
- . Training Quality Improvement Measures Committee for each department
- . Departmental and subject experts to help in identifying training Resource Persons right up to sub divisional level.

- . Multiday F2F training to be done only up to Sub divisional level
- District level : Maximum 3days.
- Sub divisional level and Nagar Panchayat : Maximum two days.
- Block level : Single day.

In campus Training Strategy:

- Each in house faculty may organize 30-35 training programmes annually at SIPARD @ 3 training programmes per month.
- Training for all Group A and Group B officers must be conducted at SIPARD campus.
- Courses may be designed based on a training need analysis.

Outreach Training Strategy:

- . Nodal officers (training) at Department, District and Sub divisional level
- . Nodal officers to help in TNA, identify trainees and coordinate with SIPARD
- . Training Managers at Sub divisional, Block and Nagar Panchayat level
- . Training Managers at all locations for logistic arrangements
- . Coordinating arrangements at SIPARD- Nodal faculty for departments and Districts

Arrangements for Training Infrastructure

- Utilization of existing logistic arrangement.
 - The meeting room of the Department / District /SDM/ Block HQ.
 - Utilization of available equipments like Smart TV/ or Projectors/ Screen, Sound System, internet connection
- Online training through Cisco WebEx.
- Exact requirements can be taken up on a case to case basis in consultation with the Training Nodal Officer and Nodal Faculty.

Monitoring and Evaluation of Training

- . Impact assessment of training through Research Wing
- . Supervision of off campus training activities by Nodal Officer (Training)

New Developments and Infrastructure

CONSTRUCTION OF NEW HOSTEL BUILDING:

The work of construction of the new hostel building (ground floor) started in 2022 with future provisions of two more floors. The work is being implemented by Rural Departments and at present finishing works such as fitting, fixing of tiles, marble, painting etc. are in progress. There is provision of 4 Double bedded rooms with attached washroom facilities. After completion of the work, 8 guests can be accommodated in the New hostel building.



CONSTRUCTION OF MULTIPURPOSE HALL:

The construction of a Multipurpose Hall was carried out by The Rural Development Department, (Engineering Wing). At present, the civil works including internal electrification has been completed. The ground floor of the building will be used as conference hall/training hall and the basement can be used for any other purpose as deemed fit. The work of seating arrangements and the other ancillary works of multipurpose hall will be starting soon.



EXTERNAL LIGHTING ARRANGEMENT

The external lighting arrangements of the SIPARD campus have been upgraded to give a new look by the Rural Development Department (Engineering Wing) as Implementing Agency. The outside lighting of SIPARD's complex is fully covered by LED lighting, which has not only increased the safety and security of the complex but also enhance the beauty of SIPARD's campus, especially by night.



BEAUTIFICATION OF SIPARD:

The beautification of the SIPARD's garden is carried out by the Horticulture Department. Some of the major activities carried out under the beautification project are, development of lawn with green carpet grass, decoration with ornamented and exotic foliage plants, semi-hardy plants and an introduction of various new indoor plants.



LIBRARY

One fully computerized Library for the benefit of trainees, research scholars, faculty members and officers of the state. There are more than 6500 books, 20 Journals and 10 Periodicals.

The catalogues of the library books are fully computerized with the help of NIC made web based e- Granthalaya Web OPAC (Ver. 3.0) software which can be accessed through the link library.tripura.nic.in/SIPARDOPAC.

The interested readers can browse the catalogues of the books based on different types of queries such as subjects, Authors, Titles, Key words. Application form for State Institute of Public Administration and Rural Development library membership is also available in the web.

Orchard :Total Mango Plant 160 nos. (Amrapali variety), Coconut, Citrus, Jackfruit, Bel.

Hedge Plant : Total area 2000 sqft. Various coloured hedge plants include Golden Durante, Ixora Variety, Ailanthus Variety, Croton bi-colour variety, Acalyphia Variety, Kamini Variety etc.

Seasonal Flower garden : Total area 3000 sqft:The flower garden has a variety of seasonal flowers. They include Marigold, Zinnia, Dahlia, Salvia, Petunia, Flox, Carnation, Cosmos, Calendula, Sunflower, Aster, Kochia, Vinca rosea, Portulaca, Poinsettia etc.

Flowering and Ornamental Garden : Total area 1200 sqft.

The flowering and ornamental garden includes, Jhau, Bougenvellia, Thvja, Mousanda, Ixora, Hibiscus, Murraya, Exotica, Gardenia Florida, Champa, Magnolia, Polyalthia longifolia, Jasmine, Cassia fistula, Delonix regia etc.

Indoor Tub Plant : The indoor tub plants includes, Arica Palm, Chinese Palm, Dracina, Auscaria cookii, Aralia, Maranta.

Medicinal Plant Garden: Total area 2200 sqft. The institute is having a very rich medicinal plants garden. The important varieties of which are *sentela asiatica*, *Azadiracta indica*, *Callotropis procera* (Akanda), *Bohervia diffusa* (Punarnava), *Asparagus racemosus*, *Emblica officinalis* (Amla), Gandhol, *Tinospora cordifolia* (Padma curuch), *Alo vera*, *Andrographis paniculata* (Kalomegh), *Ocimum sanctum* (Black Tulsi) etc.

Floriculture: Keeping in view of the increasing demand, SIPARD is planning to different variety of Orchids, Tube Rose as well as Marigold in different paradigm which may be utilized in commercial purpose also. Climatic Condition of Tripura adds to the pristine pure environment inside SIPARD campus. One can easily understand that the campus is very rich in terms of Biodiversity. The song of the birds and the variety of insects as well as the butterflies present here. Fishery practice is on its way in own shallow pond specially designed, the source of water of which is the water which comes out of the water distillation plant of SIPARD.



Catering Service of SIPARD

The catering facility of SIPARD is made available for the entire staff and the participants attending training programmes in SIPARD during the weekdays. This facility is also made available to the participants staying in SIPARD hostel during the holidays prior to commencement of any training programme or post training programme. The catering service is provided through a tender process. The present Caterer is Mr. Pradip Das.

The two wings are headed by a senior faculty of the Institute who are being assisted by fulltime staffs of the Institute. The activities of the Research Wing inter alia are :

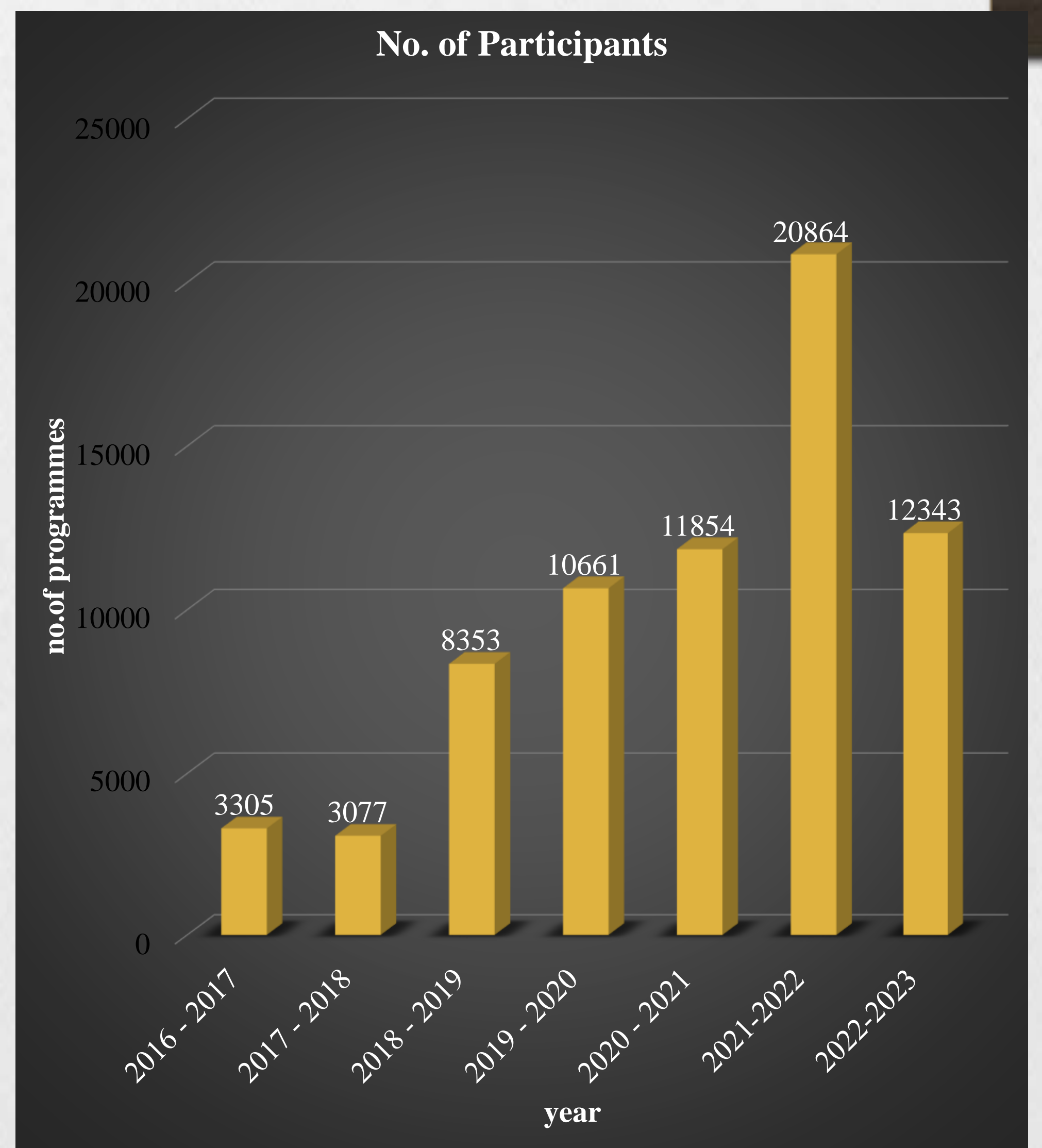
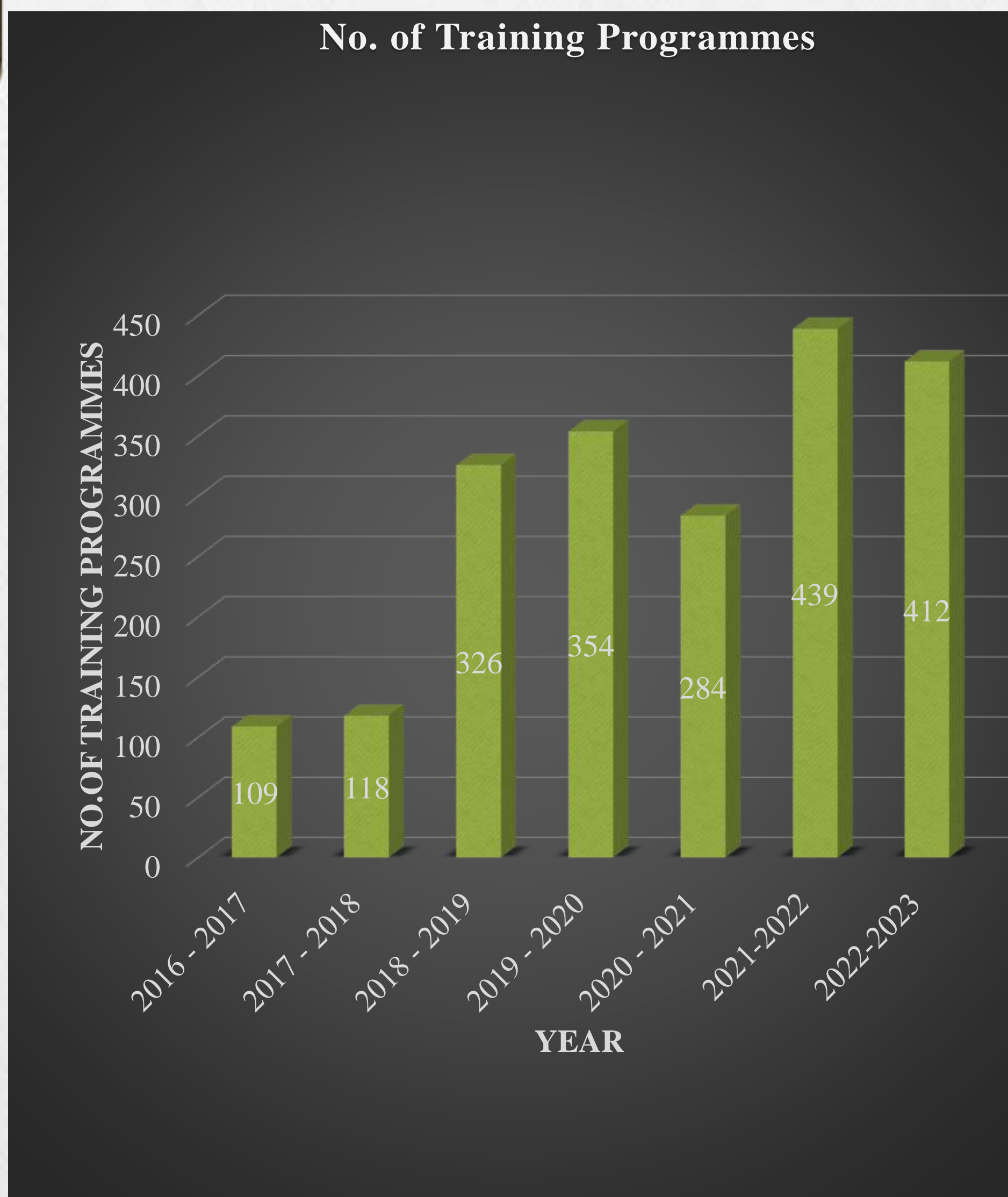
- To coordinate for undertaking Research studies by the faculty of the Institute.

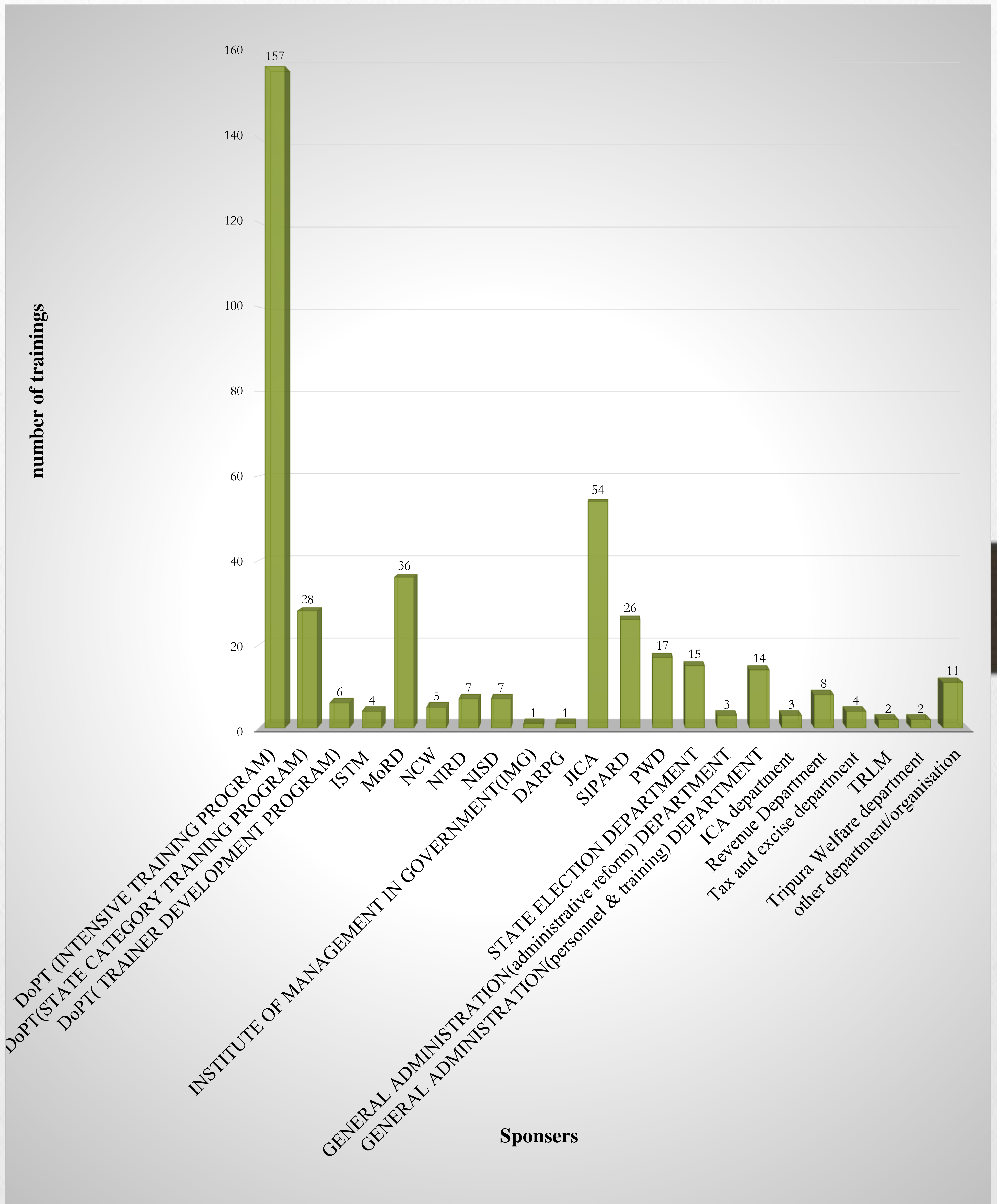
- Prepare, maintain and implement training plan for capacity building of all Government Employees of the State

Centre for Good Governance in SIPARD

For improving the standard of governance, the State Government of Tripura felt a need to establish a center to undertake Governance reforms in Tripura by bringing together knowledge, soft skills, technology and people. Thus, the Government of Tripura decided to set up a Centre for Good Governance in the SIPARD vide notification No. F.SIPARD/2(41)/2020 dated 28.6.220 with the following objectives :

- To study and assimilate good governance knowledge and practices in other states and countries, including the private and academic sectors
- To identify governance gaps through systematic research and developing suitable social accountability tools and techniques for addressing those gaps
- To improve mechanisms for promoting citizen centric governance through capacity building
- To create a platform for networking with different organizations and individuals working in the field of good governance in such a way that they are mutually benefitted
- To function as a state repository on information on best practices, initiatives and methodologies that promote good governance, e-governance, innovation and change management within the government
- To organize seminars, conferences, workshops and trainings on good governance and
- To provide consultancy to other requisition agencies.

Accordingly, Shri. Pramatha Ranjan Bhattacharjee, IAS(Retd), joined as Head, Centre for Good Governance on 23.08.2021.

Update from Head, Centre for Good Governance (CGG):

The Centre for Good Governance set up in SIPARD, has taken up two works namely **'Assessing the Working System'** of six Departments given namely

i. Social Welfare and Social Education,

ii. Fisheries

iii. PWD (Drinking Water and Sanitation)

iv. Panchayats

v. Urban Development and

vi. Transport Departments with the active cooperation of the Departments.

In the first phase, is the study of challenges faced by the Department, the manpower distribution and their functioning which is to be discussed and assessed critically. This assessment will try to come out with suggestive inputs for efficient delivery of services based on discussions and study of best practices adopted by other states in the country.

The second phase is regarding the **'Capacity Building'** of Officials specially at the cutting edge level, who are directly involved with the service delivery of the Department. Ten such Departments have been shortlisted namely, Social Welfare and Social Education, Fisheries, PWD (Drinking Water and Sanitation), Panchayats, Urban Development, Agriculture, Health, Power, PWD (R&B) and Animal Resources Development Departments. Evaluation of the existing training modules, their upgradation as per the suggestions, requirement of the Departments, and linking Institutional Training in SIPARD for enhancing their skill and ethics will also be looked into in the second.
